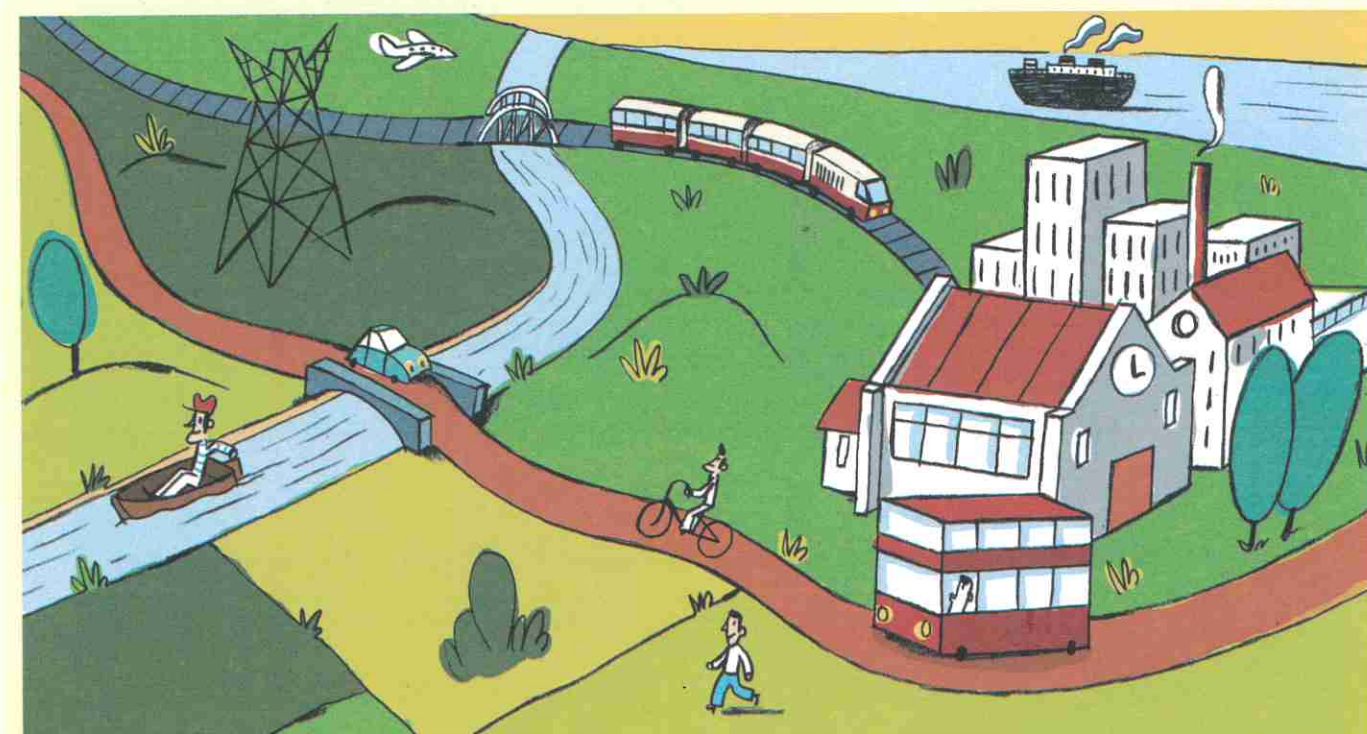

Means of transport



Pour se déplacer, on peut utiliser les moyens de transport suivants : a bike, a boat, a bus, a car, a coach, a plane, a ship, a train.

- The **bike** is on the road, near the town.
- The **car** is just on the bridge.
- The (small) **boat** is on the river.
- The (big) **ship** is on the sea.
- The **bus** is on the road, just behind the cyclist.
- The **train** is on its track between the town and the railway-bridge.
- As for the **plane**, it is flying over the fields, in the background.
- As for me, I travel **on foot**: I am in the first field in the foreground on the right.
