So, what animals can you expect to see on a safari in South Africa? Well, a huge range, to be honest. South Africa is home to over 500 bird species, 100 species of reptile and 150 mammal species, including the Big Five and the endangered African wild dog.

Seeing the Big Five – lions, leopards, rhinos, elephants and Cape buffaloes – is the ultimate safari challenge. [...] You'll probably see a range of other animals too, including zebras, giraffes, cheetahs¹, kudus² (deer with large ears and impressive, curling horns), springboks² (South Africa's national animal), warthogs³, crocodiles, hippos, various birdlife and many more.
