No, she **doesn't**. She's a teacher.

Do they come from Germany?

Yes, they **do**.

Do you live with your parents?

No, I **don't**. I have a room at the university.

Does your brother play football?

No, he **doesn't**.

Does your cousin like chocolate?

Yes, she **does**.

Do you visit your grandparents on Sunday?

Yes, we **do**.

Does she study hard?

Yes, she **does**.

Do they listen to the music in the evening?

No, they **don't**. They listen to the music in the afternoon.

Do you speak French?

No, I **don't**. I speak German and Spanish.

Ask questions as in the example:

He likes playing basketball (football?)

Does he like playing football?

Yes, he does.

They go to the cinema. (to the theatre?)

Do they go to the theatre?

No, they don't.

My mum likes coffee. (tea?)

Does your mum like tea?

No, she doesn't

They like the cake. (the doughnuts?)

Do they like the doughnuts?

Yes, they do.

You know my sister, Rose. (brother, Tim?)

Do you know my brother, Tim?

No, I don't.

She gets up early on weekdays. (at weekends?)

Does she get up early at weekends?

No, she doesn't.

I teach children. (at a primary school?)

Do you teach children at a primary school?

Yes, I do.

He starts work at 9 o'clock on weekdays. (on Saturdays?)

Does he start work at 9 on Saturday?

No, he doesn't.

We tidy our room on Friday. (on Monday?)

Do you tidy your room on Monday?

No, we don't.
