

PRESENT SIMPLE ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY



- always
- usually
- often
- sometimes
- rarely
- never

We put adverbs of frequency:
before the main verb
We sometimes go to the cinema on Sunday.
after the verb to be
He is often late.
between the auxiliary verb and the main verb
I don't often drink coffee.

Add the adverb of frequency in the right place:

- e.g They don't work at weekends. (usually)
They don't *usually* work at weekends.
- He teaches in the morning. (always)
