Prehistory VS Now



Use the words: prehistory, caves / stone / fire / necklaces, musical instruments, bowls, ceramic / animal bones

In Prehistory people lived in caves. There were stone tables and stone beds. There was a fireplace in the middle of the room. There were ceramic bowls for food, musical instruments and necklaces. They made them from animal bones.



Use the words: now, flats / wooden / fire / lamp, pictures, window

Now people live in flats. There are wooden tables and beds. There isn't usually a fireplace. There are big windows, pictures on the wall, computers and TVs.



Use the words: prehistory, outside/ fire, cook / toys / bones, play / tools, stone, make

In Prehistory people were often outside. They cooked food on the fire. There weren't any toys. Children played with animal bones and stones. Men made tools from bones and stones.



Use the words: now, outside / cooker / metal, wood, tools / playground / slide, swing

Now people are often outside, too. But we don't usually cook on the fire, we cook on a cooker. Men make tools from metal and wood. Children play at the playground. There are slides, swings, a sandpit and a seesaw.
