### **Sarcophagi were stolen from Saqqara**

New archaeological treasures, including a funerary temple dating back more than 2,500 years and more than fifty wooden sarcophagi dating from the New Kingdom (16th-11th century BC) have been found in the necropolis of Saqqara, located in the south of Cairo. In 52 burial pits ten to twelve meters deep, the ministry said.
