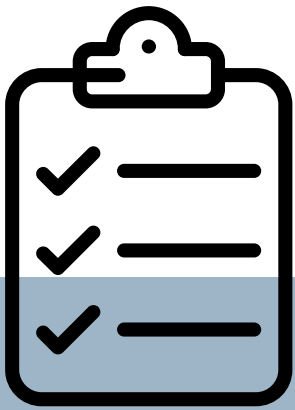

- WE VISITED AN ORGANIC FARM WITH 185 HECTARS OF GRASS. THE FARM HAS ABOUT 100 DAIRY COWS OF DIFFERENT BREEDS LIKE MONTBÉLIARDE, SIMMENTAL, NORMANDE, AND JERSEY, AND ALSO 100 SHEEP. ALL THE ANIMALS EAT GRASS USING A SYSTEM CALLED ROTATIONAL GRAZING.

- THE FIELDS ARE ORGANIZED WITH HEDGES, ELECTRIC FENCES, WATER TROUGHS, AND GRASS.
-
- HEDGES ARE IMPORTANT BECAUSE THEY HELP STOP SOIL EROSION AND KEEP THE WATER CLEAN. ELECTRIC FENCES ARE USED TO KEEP THE ANIMALS INSIDE THE FIELDS SO THEY DO NOT RUN AWAY. WATER TROUGHS GIVE WATER TO THE COWS AND SHEEP. GRASS IS THE MAIN FOOD FOR THE ANIMALS.

We had a sports day. We went climbing.



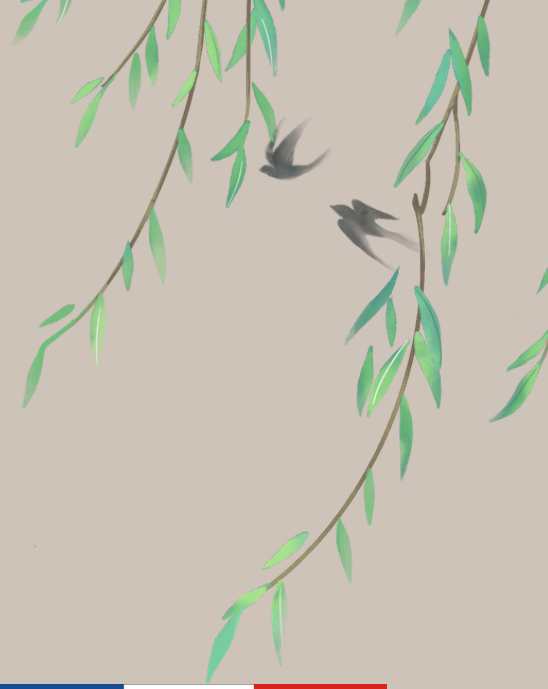

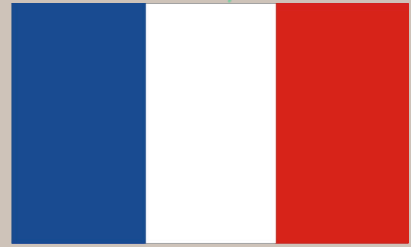
