European Dinner

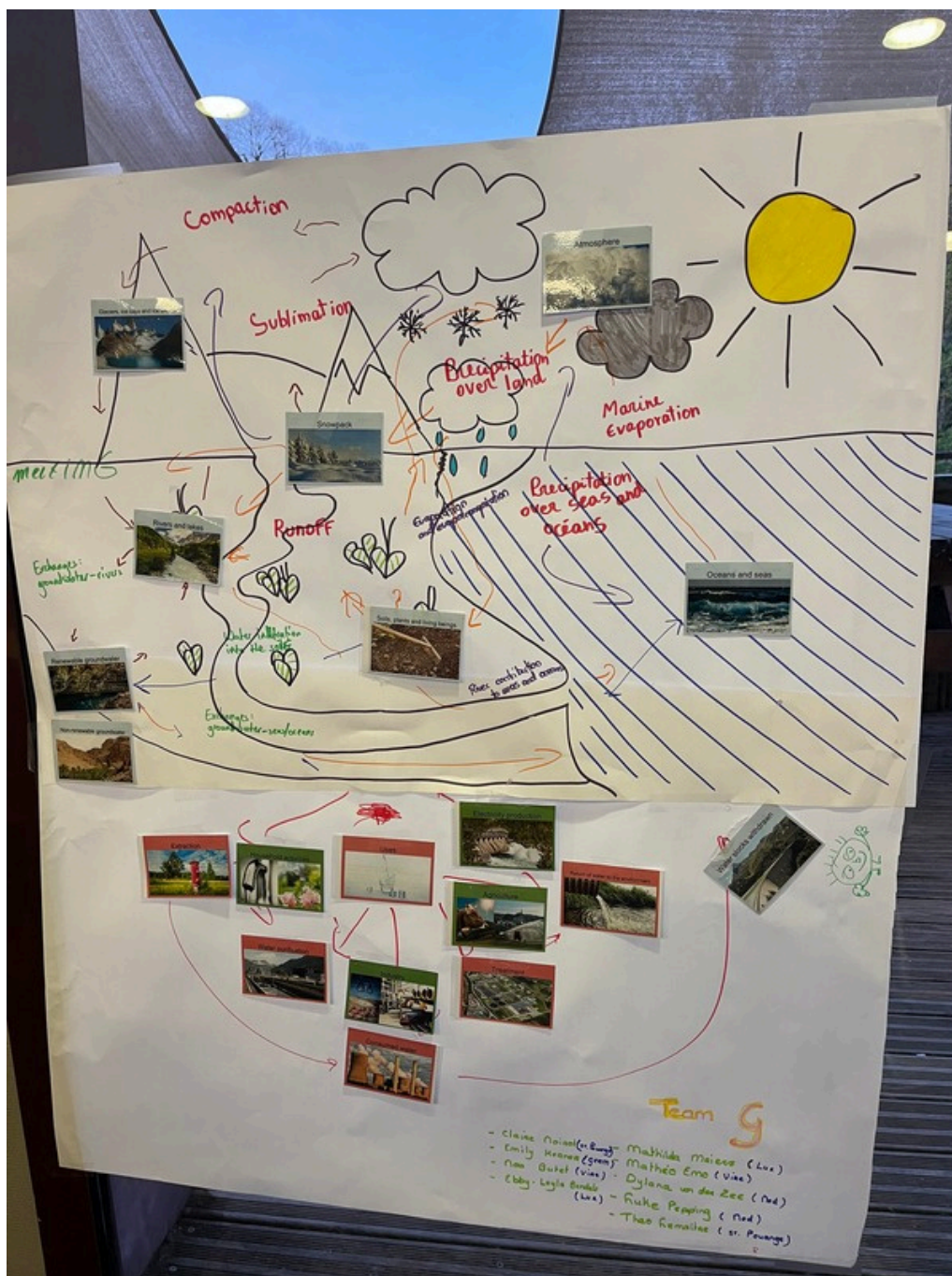
Once all the groups from the different countries had arrived, each group prepared a buffet and we were able to eat.

Afternoon : Visit of natural site back to wilderness “La Carneille”

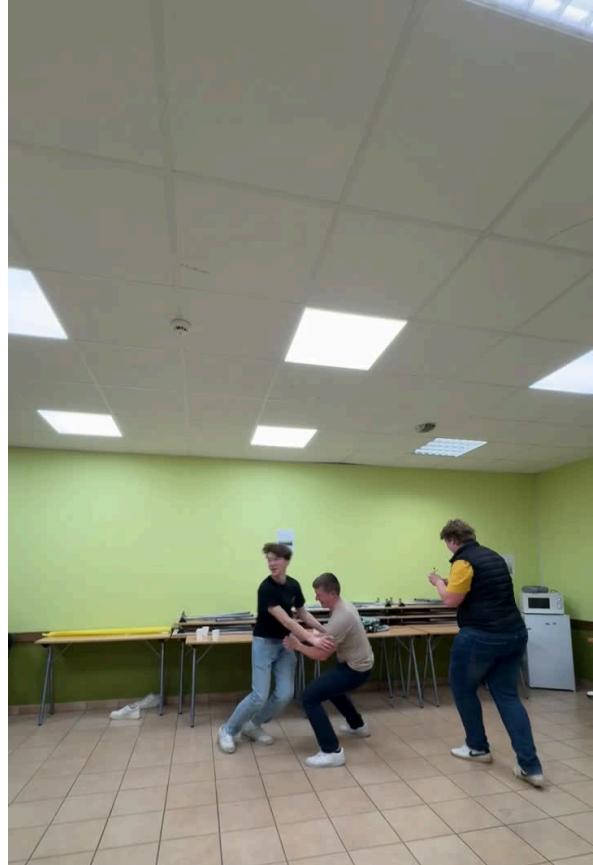
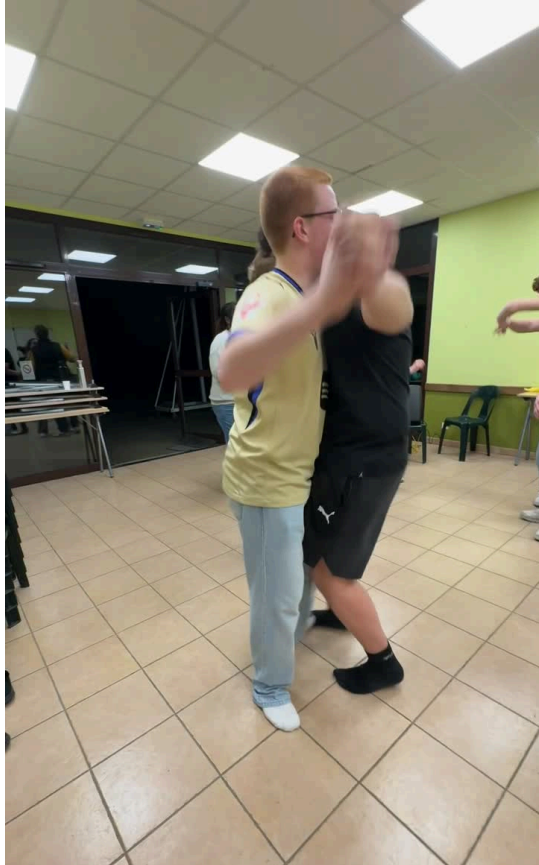
We were given the opportunity to visit a river undergoing restoration. We took a close look at the problems caused by its previous degradation and the solutions that have been found to address them.

We visited a lake where we learned about its purpose, how it is used, and the animals living there. It was fun and really cool.”





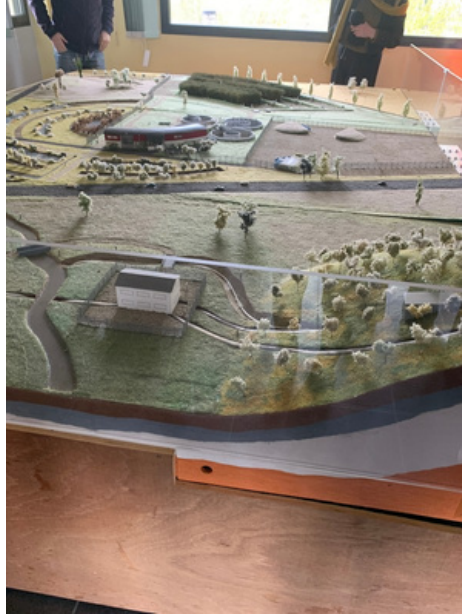

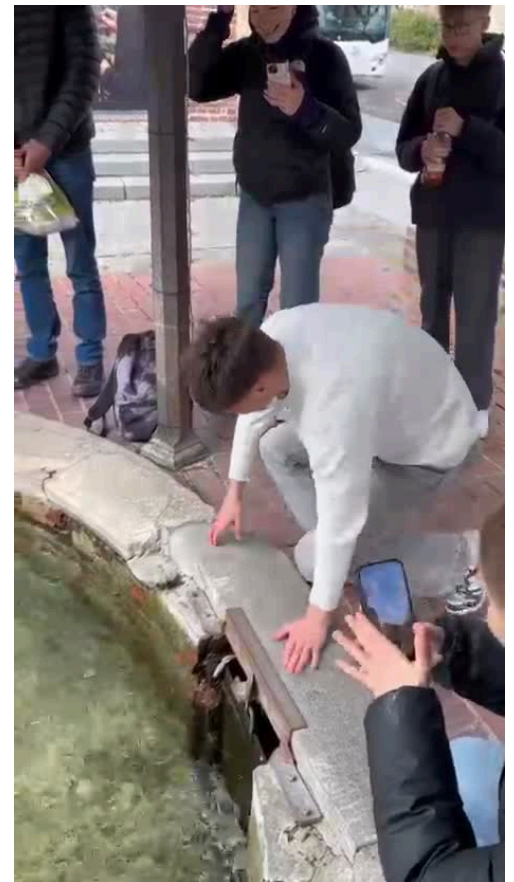
Water Waste treatment plant Visit Honfleur

After that we were allowed to explore Honfleur for two hours, they also reserved a big room for us where we could spend our time and eat

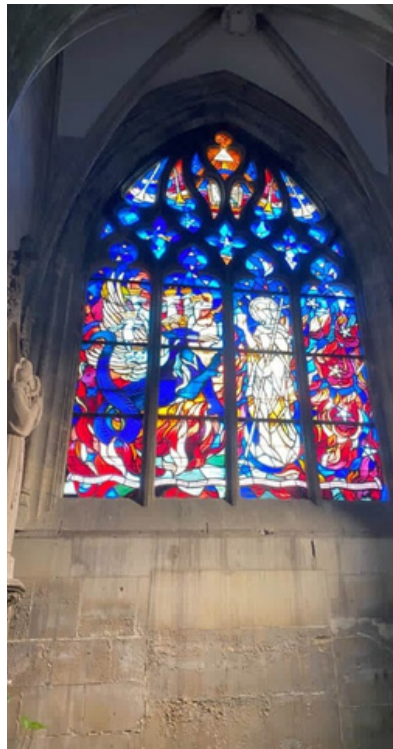




Day 4
