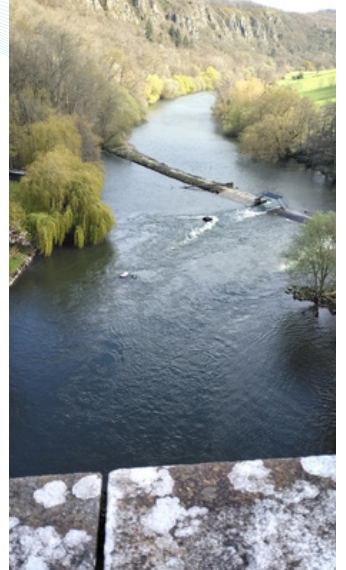

# European dinner



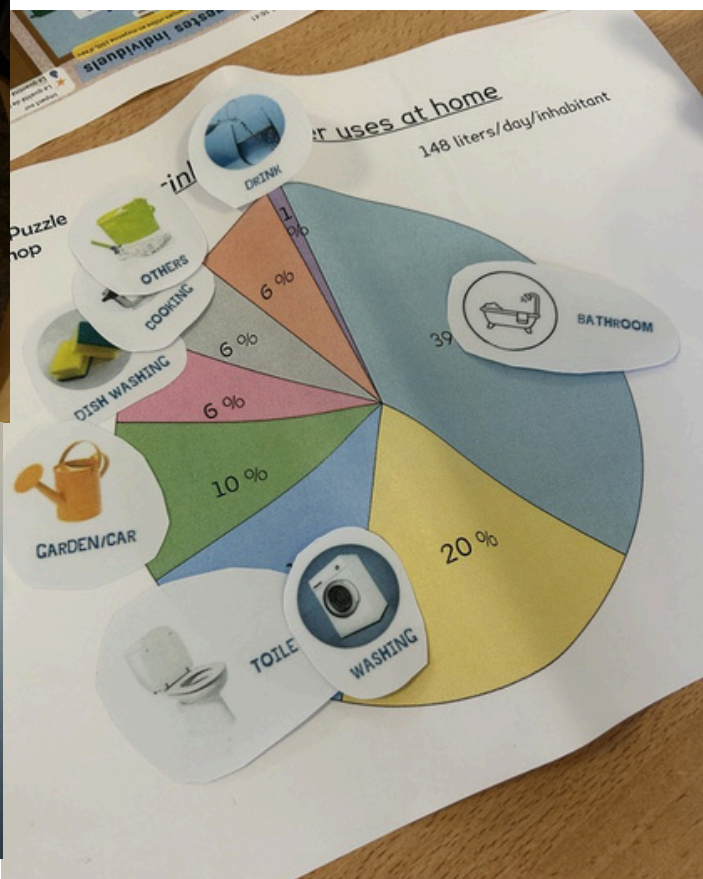
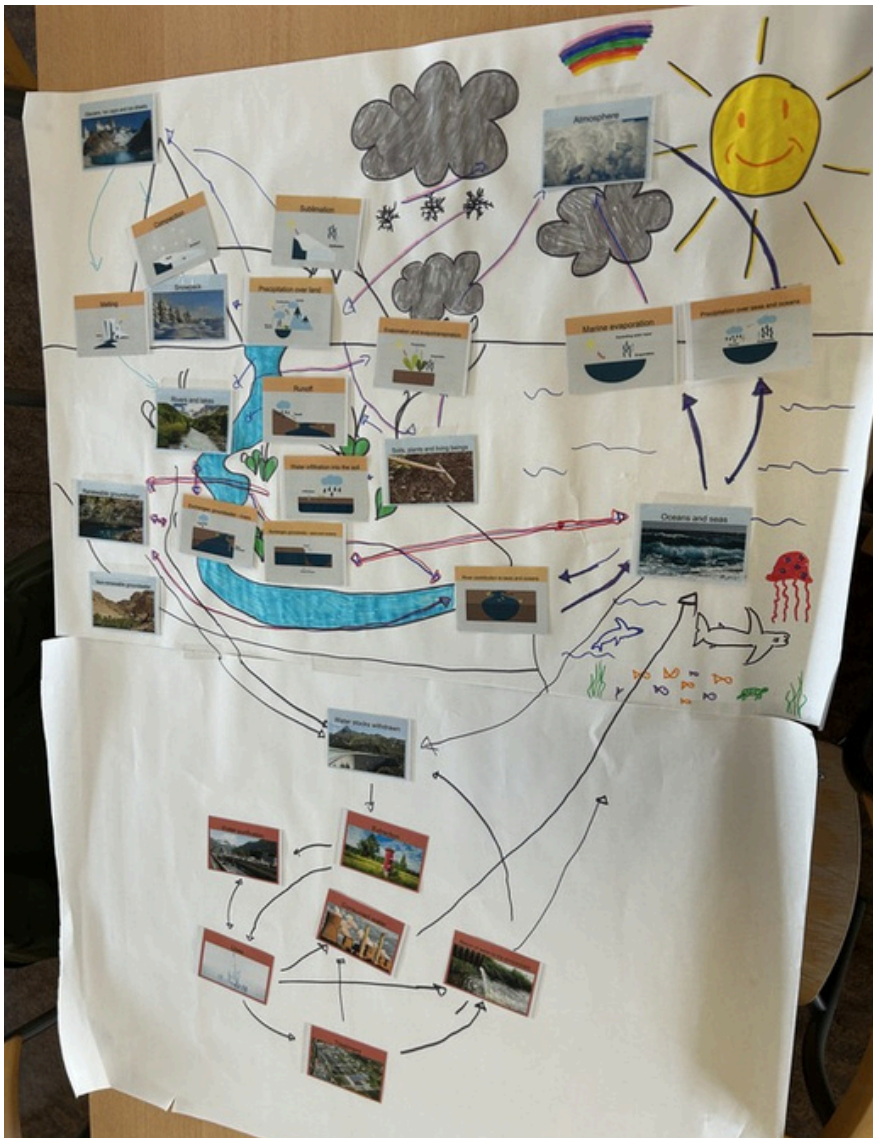
After everybody got here every school/country started to plate and cook the specialities from their country, which was great and we got to know about everyones food. After the dinner most of the people started to talk with the others.



# Monday (Day 1)

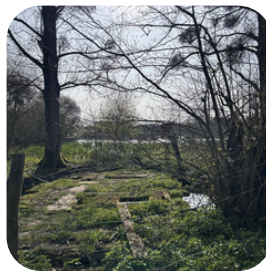
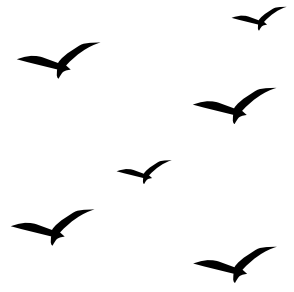
## Morning

In the morning after breakfast we met our team for the first time. Then we started to play games to learn about where water comes from, how we use it and how much we use in a day.

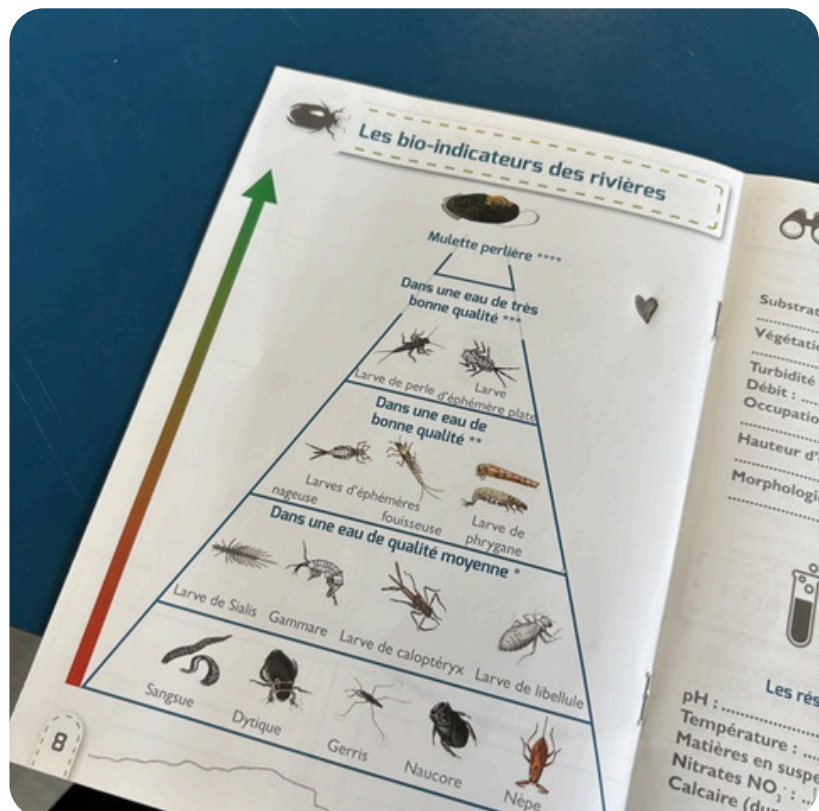


# Monday afternoon

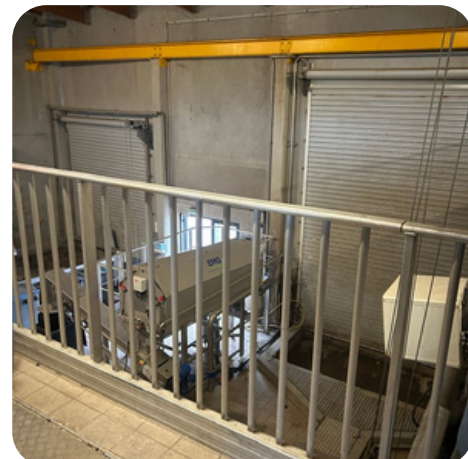


# Wednesday
