Les pronoms personnels permettent de remplacer les noms. Ils peuvent être sujets ou compléments.

### LES PRONOMS PERSONNELS SUJETS

I

he, she, it  
we

they



**He** s'emploie pour le masculin. **She** s'emploie pour le féminin. **It** s'emploie généralement pour le neutre (objets, animaux). Mais on emploie **he** ou **she** pour un animal domestique. **You** sert à traduire "tu" et "vous".
