Le présent en BE + ING sert à parler de choses, d'événements qui sont en cours de déroulement (= qui sont en train de se passer).

Il se forme de la façon suivante : auxiliaire BE conjugué au présent (am / is / are) + base verbale (= verbe non conjugué) + -ING.
