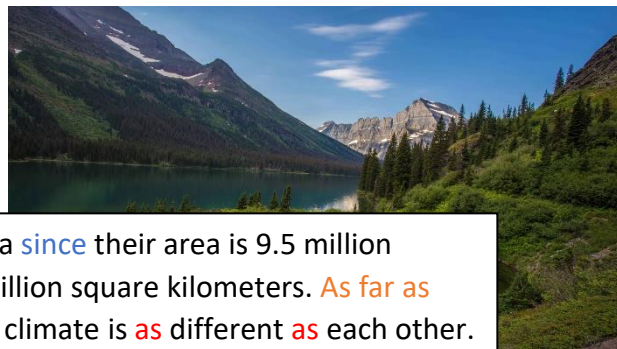


Let's compare the United States to Australia - Corrigé



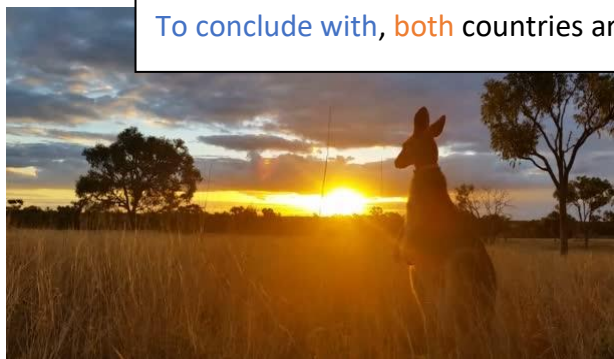

For instance = par exemple (= for example)

Even = même (dans le sens « et même ça ! », pas dans le sens « la même chose »)

On the contrary = au contraire

Even if = même si

Such as = comme (= like)

To be worth + verbe-ing = valoir la peine de

Exemple : It is worth staying home = ça vaut la peine de rester chez soi.
