





































Roll a Picasso portrait

Instructions for teacher:

Students will roll the dice and for each roll they will look at the dice drawing sheet to pick out a part for a Picasso-like face. For example, for the first roll, they will pick out a face shape, for the next two rolls, they will pick out two different eyes, ... When they will finish they will draw each part of their Picasso-like face and they will colour it.

Instructions for students :

T : Work by pairs. Roll the dice and each time tell your friend his number head shape, eyes... First, roll the dice to see what head face your friend will draw. Then continue with the eyes,...

- Student A / First roll : I roll the dice for you. Your head shape is number 4.
- Student B / I circle the head shape number 4.
- Student A / Second roll : I roll the dice for you. Your first eye is number 6.
- Student B / I circle the eye number 6.

- Now change over!
- It is a combination of the head face number 4, the eyes numbers 6 and 5...
Here's my Picasso-like face.

T : When you have finished, draw each part of your Picasso-like face and colour it with your felt pens.
