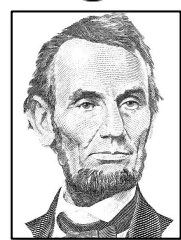

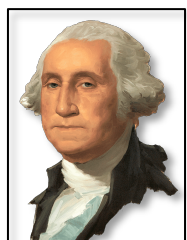

**3 Washington Monument**

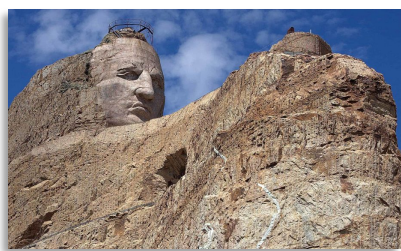
