1. A CITY: Belfast

- Belfast is the capital city of Northern Ireland
 - Northern Ireland is one of the 4 nations of the United Kingdom / Great Britain
- CLUE = a dry dock is a facility in a harbour where we can build Ø boats / Ø ships

2. A COMPANY: The White Star Line, in the city of Liverpool, England

- the red line enterprise the red flag incorporation the white star line
- This company was specialised in sea travels

3. AN INDUSTRY: Harland & Wolff Engineering

- These men are writing books drawing plans studying mechanics
 - They must be designers students businessmen naval architects/engineers
- CLUE = Harland & Wolf Engineering is probably designing Ø boats / Ø ships

4. FACILITIES: The Great Gantry

- This facility is situated in a harbour
- With the great gantry, we could build a boat, a ship

5. A WHISTLE:

steam energy was used to produce that sound.

6. ARTEFACTS: The iron rivets

There were over 3 million (number) iron rivets (name) on this object to fix the pieces together and built it.

7. A MAN: Edward John Smith

- He was working for the British military forces in the air at sea on earth.
- He commanded Ø boats / Ø ships / Ø vessels.
- In the army, he was a Captain.

8. A SPECIAL MISSION: To deliver the mails by railway by the sea through the air
RMS stands for Royal Mail Service

9. A WRECKAGE: *to wreck = to destroy with great violence*

- a. The images were recorded from the depths of the Atlantic ocean (*les profondeurs*)
- b. On these images we can see the deck of a ship (*le pont*)

10. A VINTAGE FILM

1912 is the end beginning of the 19th century

11. A HORRID LIST OF dead and missing people :

Something terrible happened on the night of April, the 14th, 1912. On the next morning, in Southhampton, a lot of people gathered (= to group together) nervously to take a look at a grocery shopping list a political speech a list of dead and missing people

12. A SHOW THAT MUST GO ON:

There were 4 different instruments on deck on that night: a stand-up bass / double-bass, two fiddles / violins, a traverse flute and a clarinet

13. AN ICEBERG:

She was brutally stopped by a huge ice cube in the Pacific ocean Mediterranean sea Indian ocean Atlantic ocean Black sea English channel (= *la Manche*)

14. A MAMMOTH SHIP: the Titanic (= *of the size of a prehistorical elephant > huge*)
