## 7 brilliant advanced English podcasts by native speakers

If you already have excellent English listening comprehension, there is a whole new world of brilliant podcast series to explore. If you aren't sure where to start, these are some of our favorites:

The Joe Rogan Experience	660 episodes with subjects ranging from comedy and science to politics and sports. Rogan is also a famous stand-up comedian, so the show is full of cultural references and idioms for those learning American English.	Exclusively on Spotify
This American Life	for English learners who want an insight into American culture. It is a mixture of journalism and storytelling, focusing on real-life tales from citizens of all regions of the United States.	<i>Giving a glimpse of what it's like living there. The way they report makes it easy to imagine being there</i>
Crime Junkie	In each 50-minute episode, the presenters discuss a different murder. They go into gruesome detail and give their theories on any unsolved aspects of the crime. It will make you shiver, but fans say it's truly addictive.	
Overheard at National Geographic	crazy stories from explorers, photographers, and scientists from around the world.	Episodes last about 20 minutes each, and topics include zombie mice, the ethics of animal selfies, and underwater pyramids. It's perfect if you want to be amazed at the strangeness of our planet.
The Writer's Voice	It's a great way to enjoy some of the best new fiction in the country – like a bedtime story for grown-ups!	
Comedy Bang! Bang!	Episodes begin as celebrity interviews but soon descend into chaos. Expect sketches, silly catchphrases, and improvisation games.	If you're new to the show, the annual review episodes are a good place to start.
Global News by the BBC	New episodes are published twice a day and report on issues that affect the whole planet. As you may have guessed, this show is beneficial if you would like to learn British English.
