- The White House** : It is the official residence and workplace of the president of the United States. It was built between 1792 and 1800.
- The US Capitol** : It is the home of the United States Congress. The original building was completed in 1800. Presidential inaugurations take place there every four years.
- US Supreme Court Building** : It is the official residence of the Supreme Court Justices of the United States. The Court leads the Judicial Branch of the government.
- Lincoln Memorial** : It was built to honor Abraham Lincoln, who was the 16<sup>th</sup> president of the United States. He succeeded in abolishing slavery in the country and he was assassinated in 1865.
- Ford's Theatre** : It opened in 1863 and it is famous for being the site of the assassination of President Abraham Lincoln.
- The US Botanic Garden**       **National Museum of Natural History**
- Dr Martin Luther King National Memorial** : MLK was the Civil Rights Movement leader and is famous for his "I have a dream" speech he gave in 1963.
- Jefferson Memorial**       **National Air and Space Museum**
- Bureau of Engraving and printing** : The place where paper money is made.
- The US National Archives** : The building holds the original copies of three important documents in the history of the United States: the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution and the Bill of Rights.
- Vietnam Veterans Memorial**       **Union Station**       **Library of Congress**
- International Spy Museum**       **National Museum of American History**
- Washington Monument** : It is an obelisk built to commemorate George Washington, who was the first president of the United States. It is the world's tallest obelisk.
