- Enchant: Attracting someone, or casting a spell over them.
- Fancy: Has a strong liking or love for someone.
- Head over heels: To be totally infatuated with someone.
- Hold dear: To have a lot of affection for someone.
- Hots for: Slang expression for desire for someone.
- Idolize: To totally love someone and not see their faults.
- Long for: To really want someone.
- Passion: A very strong love for someone.
- Rapture: The feeling you get when you are in love.
- Spark: The attraction between two people.
- Sugar baby: A nickname for your partner.
- Treasure: Consider valuable or rare
- True love: Your lover or soul mate
- Worship: To adore intensely.
