

Water for Elephants – Sara Gruen

You have been given a book to read beforehand. You will have 4 weeks to complete a Memory Log Book and hand it over to your teacher.

This Log Book will contain 8 parts, matching different chapters from the book.

You will need to show what you have understood of the reading, by illustrating the given words and others of your choice.

Twice a week, you will share your understanding and findings with 3 different people in the class. You may exchange your ideas, ask questions, try to have a better understanding or gather some ideas of how to illustrate your Memory Log Book.

In the end, as a Final Task, you will be handed someone's Memory Log Book and will have to speak about a specific page of it: describe, criticize, compare it with yours for 5 minutes.

The 8 parts + words are the following:

Prologue + Chapter 1 – 2 – 3: Memory – Ivy League – Poland

Chapter 4-5-6: Prohibition – circus – respect

Chapter 7-8-9-10: help – food – The Great Depression

Chapter 11-12- 13: Merlina – train – Competition

Chapter 14-15-16- 17: Recognition – family – Rosie – language

Chapter 18 – 19-20 -21: fight – bliss – forgetfulness – hope

Chapter 22- 23- 24 – 25 : danger – love – Runaway

Instructions for your Memory Log Book:

The size of each page must be A4.

The presentation will need to fully illustrate the given words, be nice to

look at and worked on.

It will contain 8 pages + the Front page.

You may use any type of illustration: photos, words, short texts, magazines clips, drawings....

Don't forget to add some words to illustrate, so as to show your own interpretation of your reading !
