Robot and Franck : comedy *Set in the near future, Frank, a retired cat burglar, has two grown kids who are concerned he can no longer live alone. They are tempted to place him in a nursing home until Frank's son chooses a different option: against the old man's wishes, he buys Frank a walking, talking humanoid robot programmed to improve his physical and mental health. The Twilight Zone (1960) : A thing about machines

I Robot : *In 2035, a technophobic cop investigates a crime that may have been perpetrated by a robot, which leads to a larger threat to humanity.*

Numero 9 : *A rag doll that awakens in a postapocalyptic future holds the key to humanity's salvation.*

The Dead don't die (2019) *The peaceful town of Centerville finds itself battling a zombie horde as the dead start rising from their graves. A strange and funny zombie movie (good even when you don't like zombie movies)*

Blade Runner : *in a dystopian future Los Angeles of 2019, synthetic humans known as replicants are bio-engineered by the powerful Tyrell Corporation to work at space colonies. When a fugitive group of advanced replicants led by Roy Batty escapes back to Earth, burnt-out cop Rick Deckard reluctantly agrees to hunt them down.*

Elysium: *In the year 2154, humanity is sharply divided between two classes of people: The ultrarich live aboard a luxurious space station called Elysium, and the rest live a hardscrabble existence in Earth's ruins. His life hanging in the balance, a man named Max (Matt Damon) agrees to undertake a dangerous mission that could bring equality to the population, but Secretary Delacourt (Jodie Foster) vows to preserve the pampered lifestyle of Elysium's citizens, no matter what the cost.*

Avatar: On the lush alien world of Pandora live the Na'vi, beings who appear primitive but are highly evolved. Because the planet's environment is poisonous, human/Na'vi hybrids, called Avatars, must link to human minds to allow for free movement on Pandora. Jake Sully , a paralyzed former Marine, becomes mobile again through one such Avatar and falls in love with a Na'vi woman . As a bond with her grows, he is drawn into a battle for the survival of her world.
