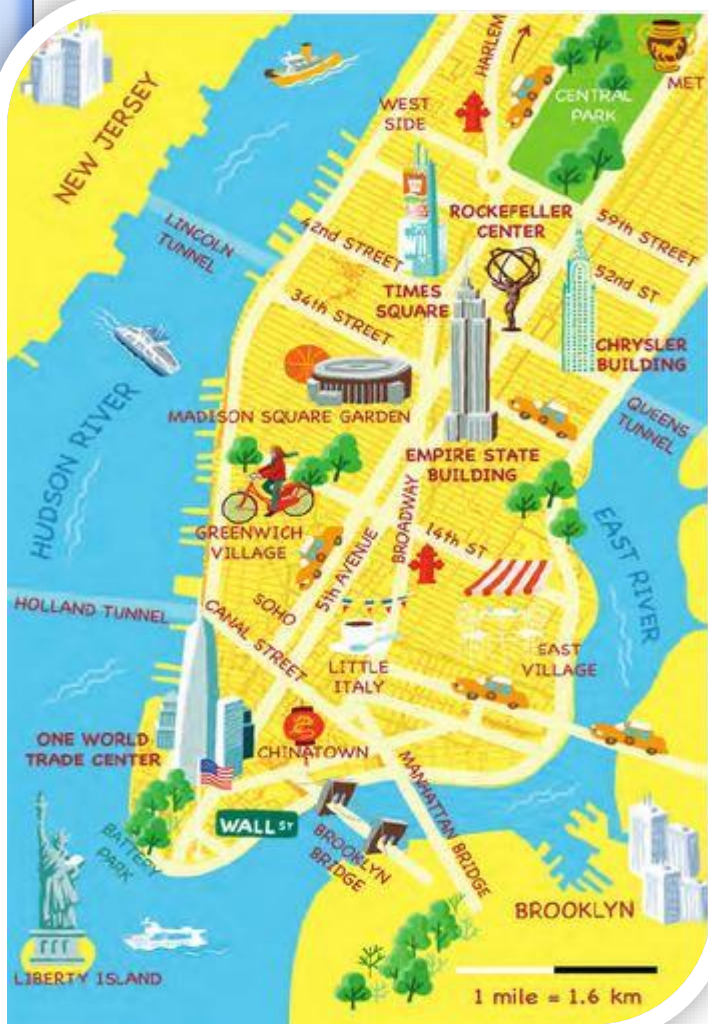

NYC Quick Facts

● New York City is located in the **north** of the USA, on the **east** coast. It is situated in the state of New York.

● There are 8.5 million **inhabitants** in NYC.



● New York City is divided into five **boroughs**:

- Manhattan
- Brooklyn
- the Bronx
- Queens
- Staten Island.

● 200 languages

● 237 skyscrapers

● 5,000 street food vendors

● 468 subway stations

● 13,000 cabs

● currency = dollar

● Manhattan forms a grid of 228 **streets** and 12 **avenues**. 2 avenues and 2 streets form a rectangle called a **block**.
