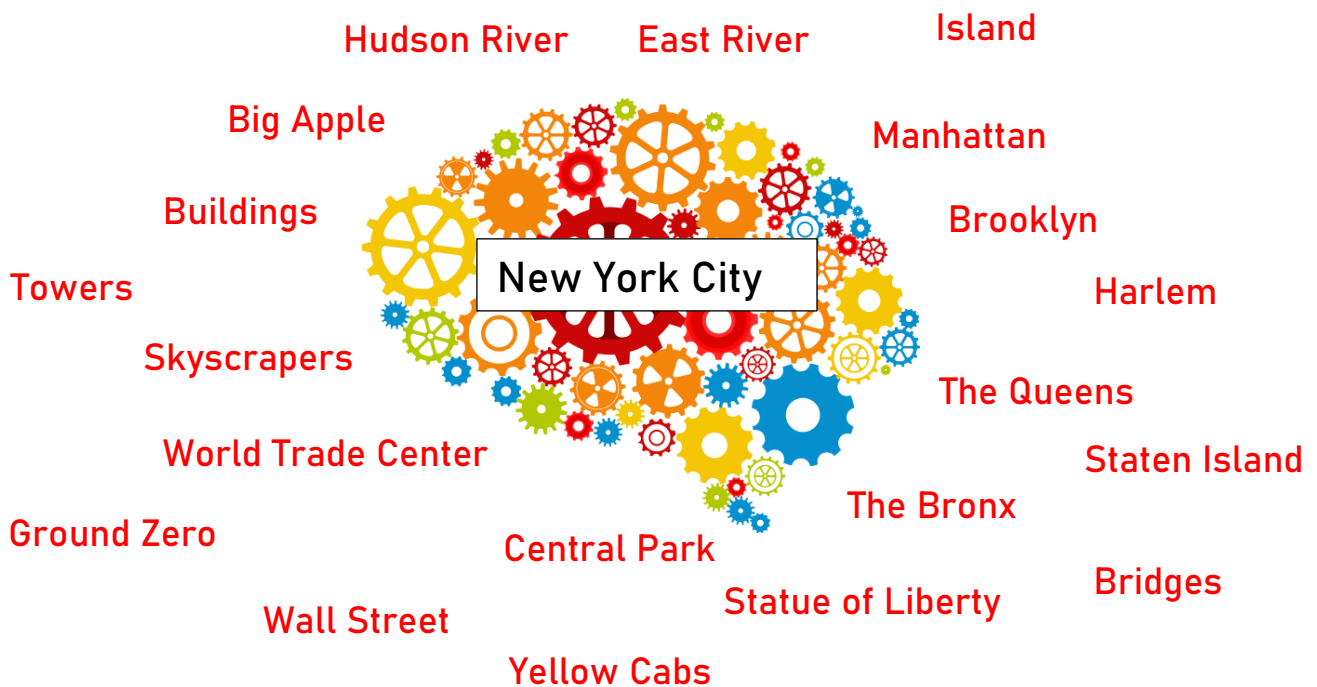
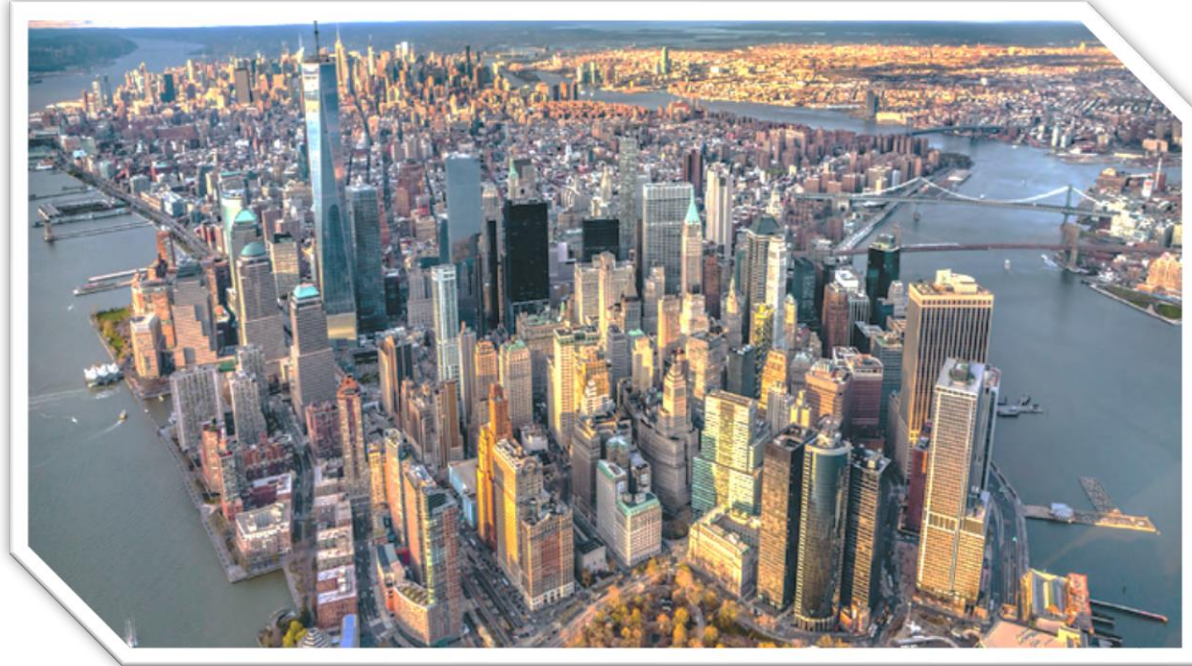

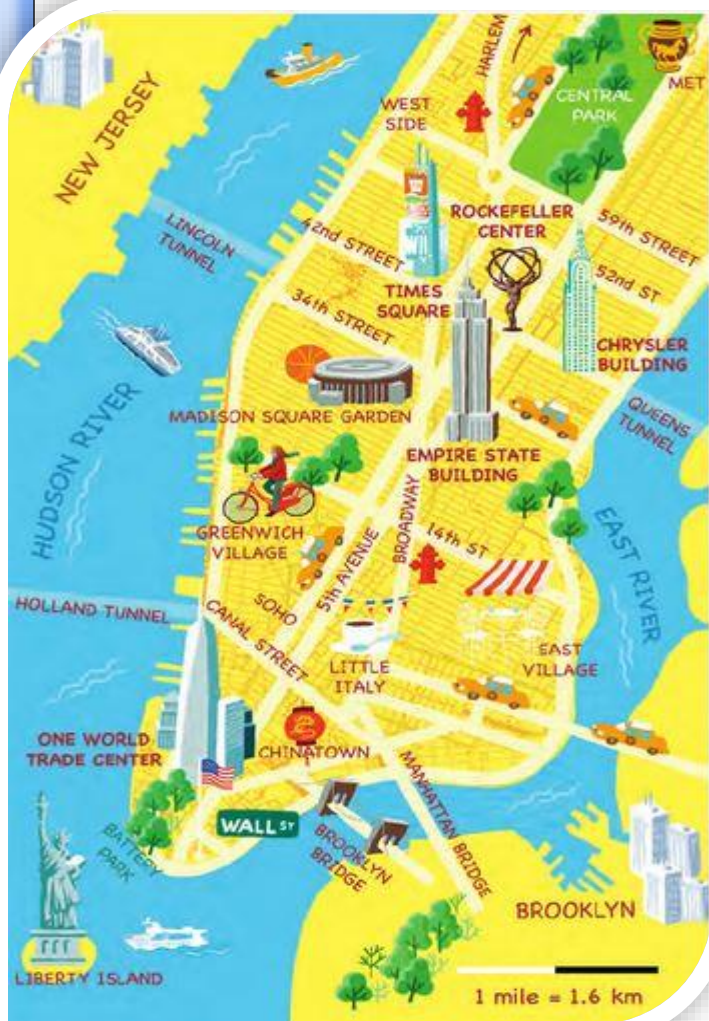

• New York City is divided into five **boroughs**:

- Manhattan
- Brooklyn
- the Bronx
- Queens
- Staten Island.

• 200 languages

• 237 skyscrapers

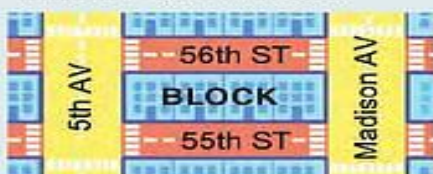
• 5,000 street food vendors

• 468 subway stations

• 13,000 cabs

• currency = dollar

• Manhattan forms a grid of 228 **streets** and 12 **avenues**. 2 avenues and 2 streets form a rectangle called a **block**.
