7 This small island was the busiest place in the 19th and 20th centuries, it was the gateway for 12 million immigrants who wanted to settle in the United States.

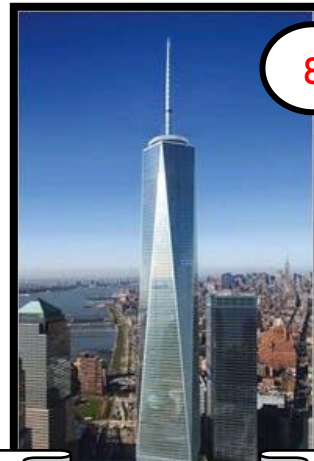
6 It is a gift of friendship from the people of France to the United States. It is a universal symbol of freedom and democracy and the most iconic symbol of NYC.

8 It is the tallest building in the western hemisphere. It was built after the 9/11 terrorist attacks. It is made of glass and steel, which look like mirrors.



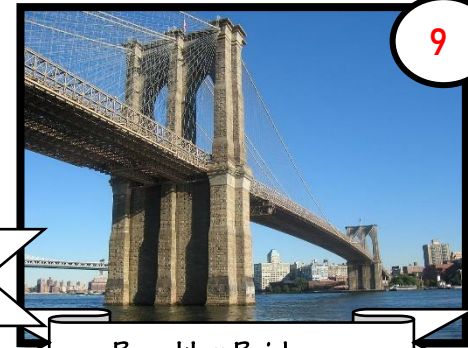

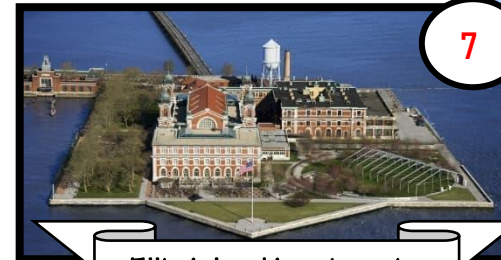
