3) Write the number for each paragraph to respect the timeline of Miss Peregrine's story.

Jacob and his dad go to Wales to see if they can find Miss Peregrine's Home.

Miss Peregrine tells Jacob about the hollowgasts (bad peculiar people) who eat peculiar children's eyes to be immortal.

Jacob runs after them and finally travels through a time loop to discover Miss Peregrine's home and the other peculiar children in 1943.

At the beginning, little Jacob wants to be an explorer just like his Grandpa Abe, who tells him stories of peculiar children and eternal life in a time where every day is the same...

Back to the place where he stays with his dad, he sees a girl who can manipulate fire with her friend : an invisible boy...

The hollowgasts kidnap Miss Peregrine because she can control time. She can't protect her home with a time loop and the mansion is bombed.

Grandpa dies in Jacob's arms, Jacob sees what killed his grandpa in the woods: a tentacle-mouthed monster.

At the end, Jacob decides to stay in the past and help Emma to find Miss Peregrine.

Miss Peregrine's mansion is abandoned : it was probably bombed during World War II.
