Les déterminants possessifs



The Queen has got three dogs:
her dogs are corgis.

Prince Charles has got a dog too:
his dog is a labrador.

- Si le possesseur est masculin → **his**
- Si le possesseur est féminin → **her**
- S'il y a plusieurs possesseurs (pluriel) : → **their**

SUBJECT PRONOUN

I	I have a shirt.
YOU	You have a book.
HE	He has a pillow.
SHE	She has a dog.
IT	It has a bone.
WE	We have a bird.
YOU	You have a house.
THEY	They have a car.

POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE

MY	My shirt is green.
YOUR	Your book is new.
HIS	His pillow is soft.
HER	Her dog is small.
ITS	Its bone is old.
OUR	Our bird is noisy.
YOUR	Your house is big.
THEIR	Their car is slow.
