1) Complete the phone call with the correct form of each verb.

"Hi Oscar ! Is your sister at home ?"

"Yes, she is. She **is playing** (play) on her new video game console. Just a minute, let me call her.

Jessie, Emily **is waiting** (wait) for you on the phone !"

"OK, I **am coming** (come) ! Hi Emily !"

"Hi Jessie ! **Are** you **coming** (come) to my party ?"

"Oh, sorry, I can't ! My brother and I **are going** (go) to visit our grandma..."

"OK, too bad..."

2) Tim is looking for his brother and sister. He finds them and calls his parents to reassure them. To complete the phone call, put the verbs into the correct present tense.

= Tim cherche son frère et sa sœur. Après les avoir trouvés, il appelle ses parents pour les rassurer.

Mum: "Thanks, Tim. Bring them home now, please. We **are having** (have) dinner in 15 minutes."
