## DES VÉRITÉS GÉNÉRALES OU PERMANENTES

Ex : I like chocolate / I live in France.  
The sun rises in the east.

**-s** : pour la plupart des verbes :

Ex : She gets up at 7.

**-es** : si la base verbale se termine par O, S, Z, X, ch, sh :

Ex : He goes to school by bus.

## RÉPONSES COURTES :

On reprend l'auxiliaire précédé du pronom sujet :

Ex : **Do** you go to school on Friday afternoons ?

Yes, I **do**. / No, I **don't**.
