Forme affirmative	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>S [singulier] + was + B<u>Ving</u> + (C).</b></p> <p><i>Ex : I was washing my hair.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>S [pluriel] + were + B<u>Ving</u> + (C).</b></p> <p><i>Ex : We were working.</i></p>
Forme négative	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>S [singulier] + wasn't + B<u>Ving</u> + (C).</b></p> <p><i>Ex : Sam wasn't listening to the teacher.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>S [pluriel] + weren't + B<u>Ving</u> + (C).</b></p> <p><i>Ex : Melissa and Carol weren't using the Internet.</i></p>
Forme interrogative	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>(mot interrog.) + was + S [singulier] + B<u>Ving</u> + (C) ?</b></p> <p><i>Ex : What was Helen doing ?</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>(mot interrogatif) + were + S [pluriel] + B<u>Ving</u> + (C) ?</b></p> <p><i>Ex : Were you going to the dentist's ?</i></p>
