

## Christmas in Australia

Australians hang wreaths on their front doors. They decorate their houses and gardens with Christmas Trees and Christmas lights. Australians also decorate their houses with **bunches** of 'Christmas Bush', a native Australian tree with small green leaves and cream colored flowers.
