In 2013 she released her book «**I am Malala**». Before that, the same year she had spoken before the **United Nations**.

When she won the **Nobel Peace Prize** in 2014, she had already met President **Barak Obama**.

By the age of 18 years old, she had become one of the most influential people in the world.

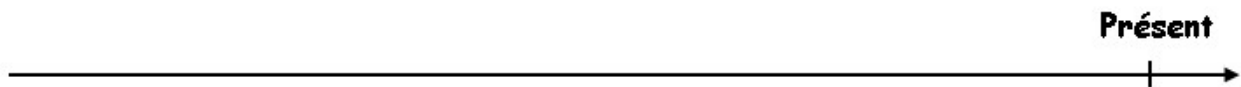
