## **The Opening Ceremony**

## **The Olympic Stadium crowd**

Although the crowd cheered on the British, there was lots of support for athletes of other nationalities too like the wonderful Usain Bolt, from Jamaica, who won the 100 and 200 metres sprint to become the fastest man alive. There was also Oscar Pistorius of South Africa who was the first disabled person to compete in the Olympics. He went on to win two gold medals and a silver in the Paralympics.

## **New sports**

I have really enjoyed being able to watch sports which are not normally shown on television. Before the **Olympics** I didn't expect to love watching judo or find myself screaming at the television during a game of wheelchair tennis, but I really got into them. Many people have said that the organisation was not as perfect as that of the Beijing Games, but there was a much better atmosphere which spread out through the whole city.
