- + affirmative: **S + am/is/are + vb-ing**
 - *I am playing in my garden now.*
- + negative: **S + am/is/are + not + vb-ing**
 - *My mother is not cooking at the moment.*
- + interrogative: **Am/Is/Are + S + vb-ing?**
 - *Are they walking in the park now?*

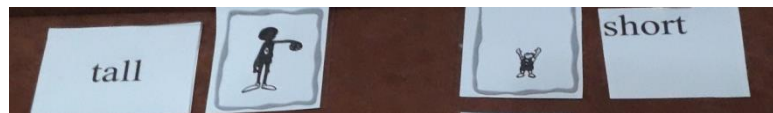

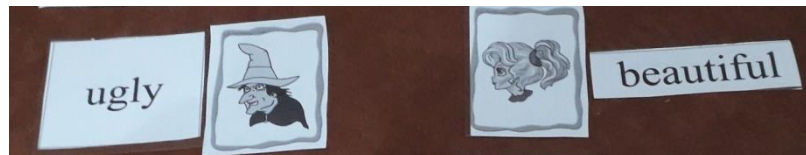
