**cave** (n) a cavern

**steal** (v, stole, stolen): take illegally

**stocking** (n) here, a big sock children leave for presents from Santa

## Help

**lots of** (exp) a big quantity. “I have 20 Christmas cards. That is *lots of* Christmas cards.”

**hang** (v) suspend

**himself** (reflexive pronoun) here, the Grinch disguises the Grinch. “At Halloween, Julie disguises *herself* as a zombie.”
