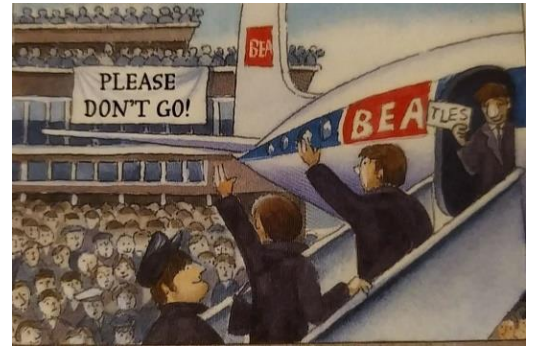


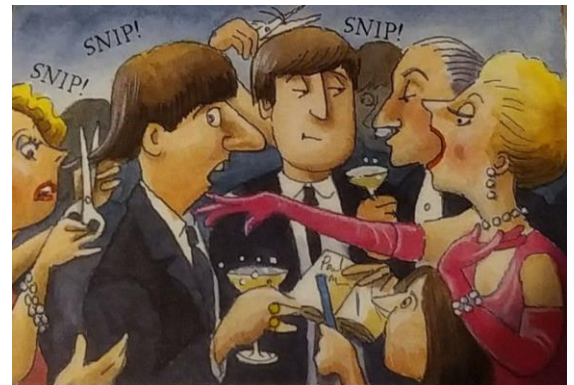


Wherever the Beatles went, huge crowds appeared. Soon people in other countries heard about them. When they went to France thousands of fans came to London Airport and begged them not to leave.
