He she it	TALKS	DOESN'T TALK	DOES HE TALK / DOES SHE TALK etc... ?

**EASY PEASY !**

Le présent simple c'est **SSSSSSSSSS** simple ! Simple avec un 's' que l'on n'oublie pas à la 3<sup>e</sup> personne du **SSSSSSS**ingulier !

I eat fish and chips → She eats fish and chips.

I don't like the Royals. → He **doe**s n't like the Royals!

Do you drink tea? → **Doe**s she drink tea?
