

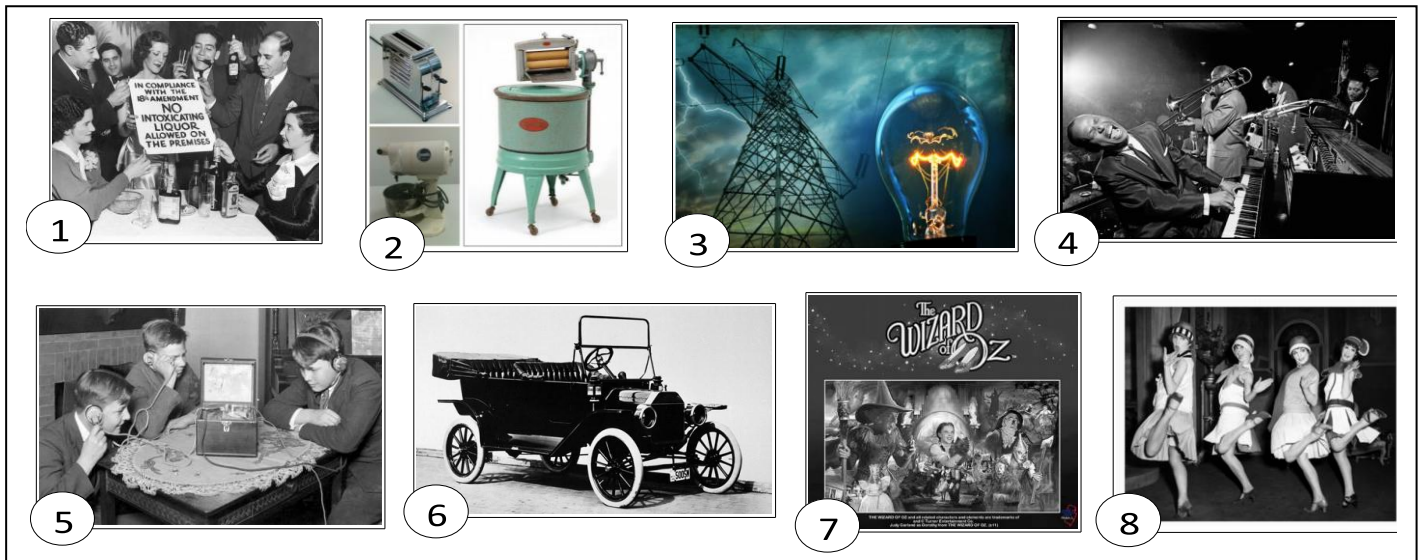
The Roaring 1920s in the USA
