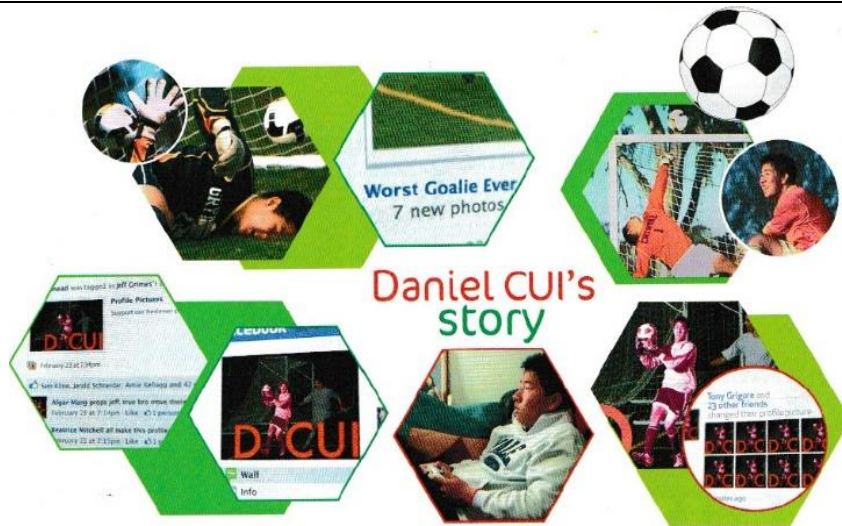


Sequence 4: "Act and React!" Niveau 3e
