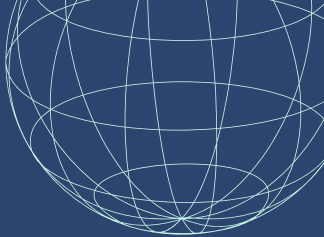


ChatGPT

Responsible Use Guidelines



BE ORIGINAL:

ChatGPT can give ideas, but your work should be your own. Use it as a brainstorming tool, but don't copy everything it says.



CHECK THE FACTS:

Sometimes, ChatGPT might give fictional and imaginary information. It might also get things wrong. Always double check the information, take a second opinion and browse through trusted/official websites/books/encyclopedia etc. for information.



GIVE CREDIT

If you use a big idea from ChatGPT, tell your teacher or class where you got it, just like you would if you found it in a book.



DO YOUR PART:

ChatGPT is here to help, but not to do everything for you. Your own thoughts and ideas are the most important!



KEEP PERSONAL STUFF PRIVATE:

Don't tell ChatGPT secrets or private things about yourself. Keep your chats about your school topics.



NOT ALWAYS RIGHT

ChatGPT is smart, but it can make mistakes. Always think and decide if what it says makes sense.
