This type of treatment does not rely on the heat or biochemical reactions that might destroy your veins. It is a quick and permanent solution that will treat the varicose. Now you might be thinking, *What happens in this treatment?* So, in this, the glue is applied to seal or close the vein permanently. This will heal it quickly without much pain during the procedure or after the treatment.



## Ultrasound Guided Sclerotherapy (UGS)

This is another type of treatment that is mostly used by many surgeons, which involves injecting a type of sclerosant solution directly into the vein that is not well. With the help of Ultrasound, the vein is found to ensure that it goes in the right vein by placing the needle into the problem vein. This is a safe way to make the treatment for the patient who is suffering from the problem.

## Radiofrequency Ablation (RFA)

This type of treatment is the same as the EVLA, which includes heating the saphenous veins from within. This is also performed under the guidance of the experts, who can help get the best final results.

Generally, RFA, when compared to EVLA, should cause less discomfort to patients since the vein will be heated more gently with the use of electromagnetic waves instead of laser energy.

## Endovenous Laser Ablation (EVLA)

It treats the large, internal saphenous veins, great and small saphenous veins, which often feed the surface veins seen with the naked eye. EVLA is a simple procedure performed under local anesthesia, using ultrasound guidance to place a laser fiber inside the problem vein. After activation of the laser fiber, the interior wall of the vein gets destroyed, making it collapse and close itself. EVLA does not leave any scars behind, unlike vein stripping.

## Sclerotherapy

In this process, a special solution into the problematic vein is injected, which causes a biochemical reaction along the vein wall. The result of this reaction is that the vein will collapse instantly and then harden over, so-called sclerosis—from where, actually, the term 'sclerotherapy' originates. Gradually, over several months, the vein will begin to fade away as it's absorbed into the system by the body.
