## What is the cost of varicose veins treatment?

Like other treatments, many factors contribute to price. But you can still expect the price of the treatment. There are many methods on which your cost of treatment depends like:

- Aftercare
- Compression stocking
- Facility fees
- Professional fees for the doctor

- Sedation cost
- Medication
- Pre-operation testing, which may include ultrasound

### **Do varicose veins covered by insurance?**

An insurance provider pays for your initial consultation and requires a primary doctor referral.

During the initial consultation, a doctor will evaluate your condition and may take digital x-rays of your legs to know more about the condition.



Your dentist will then send this information to the insurance provider; they will provide authorization after reviewing the notes and checking the reason for treatment. Even if your half treatment is cosmetic, this can be considered medically necessary.

An insurance provider will check whether you are experiencing the following condition as a result:

- Burning and aching sensation
- Weakness
- Discoloration
- Skin ulcer
- Throbbing pain
- Heavy legs

You may have to pay insurance and deductible if you need medical treatment. Because they may have negotiated rates, which impacts how much you spend.

### **How much do varicose veins cost without insurance coverage?**

If you don't have insurance coverage, you don't need any medical necessity because you will have to pay for the procedure for which you have to sell your arms and legs.

Fortunately, a veins doctor can offer payment plans and discount to cover the extra burden on you.

### **Spider vein before sclerotherapy**

For spider veins, a veins specialist will suggest sclerotherapy. The procedure may cost you \$350 per session for people without coverage. This may vary according to the doctor, state, and severity of the case.

It's not uncommon to need various sessions to eliminate further sessions, especially if both your legs need to be treated. A doctor can estimate the number of sessions during the initial appointment or after the thorough diagnosis.

Sometimes you need advanced treatment, including Varina foam injection, which may cost you tons of dollars. The cost may also vary and depends on the number and the size of veins to be treated.
