## 2. Misaligned Tracks:

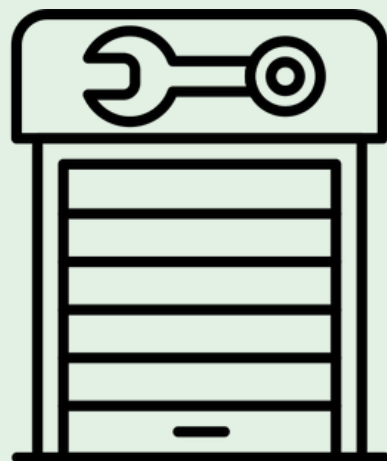
