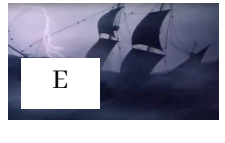
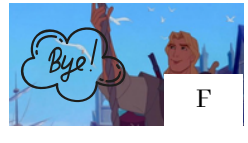
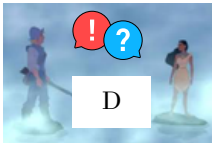
After a fight between settlers and natives, Powhatan orders the natives to stay away from the Englishmen.
