INSTRUCTIONS:

WORK AS A TEAM OF 4 to 5 STUDENTS. THERE ARE 6 CHALLENGES TO FIND THE CODE WHICH UNLOCKS THE TREASURE.

1- FIND A NAME FOR YOUR TEAM.

2 - EACH STUDENT MUST BE ASSIGNED AT LEAST ONE MISSION.

TAKE UP EACH CHALLENGE ONE AFTER THE OTHER. YOU MUSTN'T START A CHALLENGE BEFORE YOU HAVE FINISHED THE PREVIOUS ONE. THE TEACHER WILL GIVE YOU ONE PART OF THE SECRET CODE AFTER EACH COMPLETED CHALLENGE.

> IF YOU DON'T KNOW SOME ANSWERS YOU HAVE 6 JOKERS WHICH ALLOW YOU TO HAVE SOME HELP FROM THE TEACHER.

> IF YOU ARE TOO NOISY OR IF YOU DON'T FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS, YOU WILL HAVE A TIME PENALTY DURING WHICH YOU WON'T BE ABLE TO WORK.

THE FIRST TEAM THAT GETS THE COMPLETE SECRET CODE AND UNLOCKS THE COMBINATION WILL WIN THE ESCAPE GAME.

Team members' Missions

> **LEADER:** He / She reads the instructions and decides the group strategy (for example: to take time to find an element or to move on to the next element and come back later on the most difficult ones / to share the tasks of a challenge between the team members or to work together/ to start with what is the easiest/ ...).

> **SECRETARY:** He / She writes on the document and check that all team members agree with the answers.

> **JOKER:** He / She comes to the teacher's desk to ask for help when the team members are stuck*. He / she also completes the document below with the secret code. * unable to understand or find an answer.

> **SPOKESPERSON:** He / She comes to the teacher's desk when the team has completed one challenge to check the results and get a part of the secret code. He / She tells the elements of the secret code to the Joker Person.

> **PEACE MAKER:** He / She is in charge of the good relationships between the team members and makes sure that there is not too much noise. He / She asks his / her teammates to remain calm and focused on the task.

CHALLENGE 6: What are the class rules?

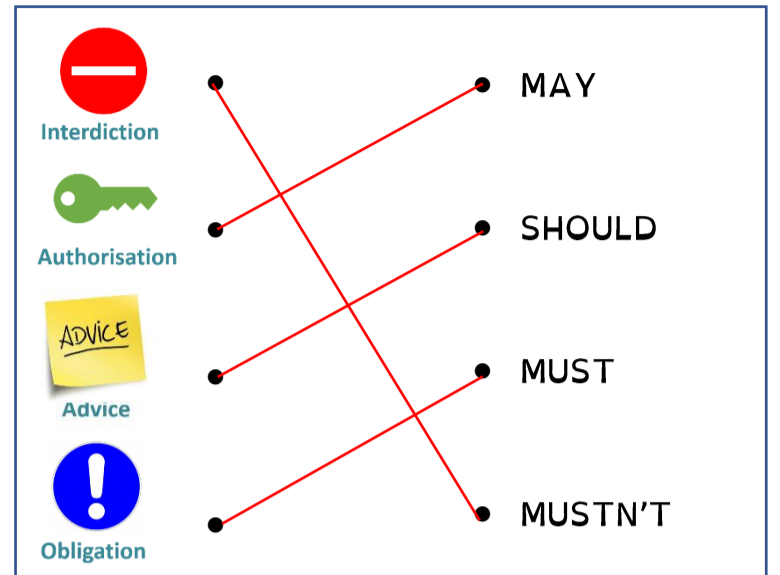
When you work in a group, it's compulsory to follow a few rules to stay organised and avoid a mess.
