

Breast Augmentation: What You Should Know?

Breast augmentation is a process of enlargement of the breast through the insertion of saline and silicone implants. These are inserted behind the breast tissue or into the chest muscle. Candidatures include those who want large breasts or a pleasing symmetry in their body.



Breast augmentation has the same collective risk as others; these include scarring, infections, skin wrinkling around the implants, pain, and more. The surgeon performs this treatment under general anesthesia.

Breast augmentation is easily accessible

Finding an authentic and certified plastic surgeon to perform your procedure for great results is essential. Initial recovery can last up to a week; depending on the conditions, it may vary accordingly.

Follow-up visits are required to check your conditions and the healing of your breast for possible complications.

Also, you may require corrections surgeries for this implant because it is a long-lasting procedure but does not last forever.

How much does it cost?

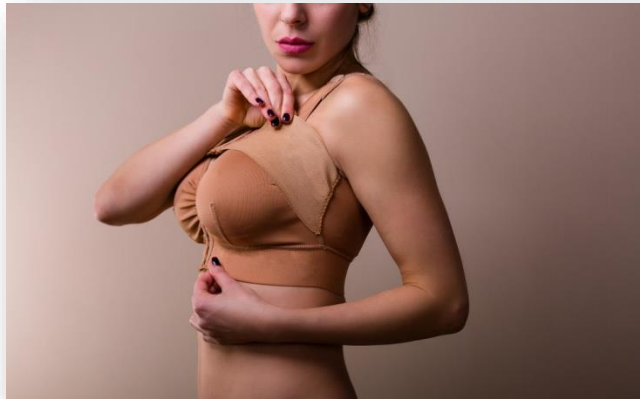

Also, this cost doesn't include facilities fees, anesthesia costs, and expenses for lab work. Also, this procedure is a cosmetic procedure, so insurance doesn't cover it, and the costs of complications associated with it are also not concealed.

How does breast augmentation work?

In this procedure, plastic surgeons insert fat tissue behind each breast by surgically taking an implant or fat tissue from other parts of your body. The implant settled either behind the muscles in your chest or behind the natural tissue; hence, this procedure can raise your breast size.

You have the option to choose a contoured and round breast implant. The basic need for this implant is to boost the size of your breast and provide the perfect shape. Keep in mind [Breast Lift](#) is a different procedure that corrects sagging breasts.

Implants are generally soft and flexible shells made of silicone-filled with saline or silicone. However, there's been some controversy surrounding the use of silicone implants, but there is still one of the favorite popular choices.



Procedure for a breast augmentation

If you have elected for breast augmentation surgery, you most probably have it done through an outpatient surgical center. Most of the time, people can go home the same day after surgery.

The surgeon performs this surgery under general anesthesia, so you don't feel anything.

Follow your surgeon's instructions 24 hours before the procedure.

- Inframammary
- Axillary
- Periareolar

Your surgeon will then create a pocket by removing the tissues of your breast from your chest muscle. And your implants or silicon will be placed in these pockets and centered inside the breast.

But if you have opted for a saline procedure, your surgeon will fill these pockets with saline solution till these shells have filled.
