If the patient's state in the hospital causes them pain, your doctor will give them stronger pain relievers or suggest other types of drugs that can limit the pain without the use of codeine. It is also recommended that patients apply cold compresses to the injured area, as this will also assist in reducing inflammation and pain.

Maintain proper hygiene

If you are having **arm lipo before and after**, you can manage the cleanliness or use of aseptic measures necessary for the surgical site not to be infected. If you are not told precisely how to clean the area by your surgeon, ask them to explain it to you. This is often done by rinsing with water and soap; most of the time, the soap used is gentle soap. It is advised that you don't go for a bath or pool for some time until the doctor clears you on the same.

Get acquainted with symptoms of infection

As for complications, look for signs like increased redness, warmth, pus, or even fever, which can mean your abscess is infected. Such symptoms, if noticed, should be reported to your surgeon as early as possible so that you don't have [bbl scars](#) later.
