Butt implants, otherwise known as gluteal implants, are surgically implanted to create a fuller and better-shaped buttock. The implants that are mostly used, normally made of silicone or solid silicone material, are designed to produce a natural tissue feel and appearance.



Butt implant surgery involves the surgical placement of these implants in the area of the buttocks. Sometimes, the incisions are made within the crease between the buttocks, which can get well hidden. Afterward, the implants will be hooked carefully, either within or above the gluteal muscle, to achieve the right augmentation. Butt implants, however, can offer permanent solutions for individuals seeking marked, full buttock appearances.

Advantages Of Butt Implants

There are several noticeable advantages to having buttock implants over other plastic surgery procedures aimed at improving the appearance of the buttocks, like the Brazilian Butt Lift. Among these are:

The implants serve as alternatives in cases where a patient does not have adequate fat tissue for the surgeon to harvest and transfer to the buttocks during a BBL.

After a Brazilian butt lift, a percentage of the inserted filler or fat cells are absorbed by the body, and patients may require further treatment to achieve their desired result. Implants should retain their shape and, as such, can provide a more certain, stable outcome.

What is BBL Surgery?

A BBL, otherwise referred to as a Brazilian Butt Lift, is a surgical procedure designed to provide an enlarged, reshaped, and more contoured appearance of the buttocks. This treatment combines liposuction and fat transfer techniques.

Excess fat is first harvested from donor areas of the body during liposuction for a Brazilian buttlift. Common donor areas include the abdomen, flanks or love handles, back, and thighs. The extracted fat will then be processed and refined to prepare only the best quality for transfer.



The purified fat is then injected at strategic locations in the buttock, evoking volume, shape, and overall symmetry. Such careful sculpting and contouring of the buttocks achieves an ideal cosmetic effect.

Advantages of BBL

No Risk of Rejection: Since it involves your own tissues, there are no chances of rejection.

Enhances More Than Your Butt: Fat is harvested from another area of the body and then transferred to the buttocks. This will enable us to enhance two areas with just one procedure. The results of your buttock augmentation shine even more when matched with a newly flatter stomach.

No Long, Hideous Incisions: One of the best features of butt implants is that the incision is incredibly well hidden, but for patients who want to avoid a long incision, the Brazilian butt lift is an okay alternative. A few

small incisions are needed for the liposuction, but since fat is injected into the buttocks, there isn't a large incision to be made.

Permanent Results: The majority of the transferred fat gets lost in a few weeks following the procedure.
