However, a number of women may develop hypertrophic or keloid scars after the procedure; such scars are raised, red, and more conspicuous compared to other scars.

Seroma and Hematoma

Some of the complications unique to the mommy makeover include seroma, the formation of a cyst-like swelling that contains serum in the operation site, and hematoma, which is similar to seroma but contains blood that has leaked outside the blood vessels. These conditions can create inflammation and pain and

may require further procedures, such as puncture of the fluid or the blood.
